Jack was born in Whitewood, Saskatchewan and was educated at Trail, Kinnaird/Castlegar and UBC where in 1970 he met the love of his life, Judy.

Jack was employed at UBC Library, Depts. of Science and of Slavonic Studies, until retirement. While a student at school he became friends with classmates of Russian heritage and began his study of the Russian language, and

the history of Russians in Canada. He was an exchange student to Moscow two different years, studying the history of the Russian exploration and settlement of the northwest coast of North America. His library years included translation of scientific papers from Russian to English. He compiled a bibliography of all writings of Doukhobor history in North America and was official court translator for the Sons of Freedom trials. At Richmond Presbyterian Church he served as an Elder and Clerk of Session as well as other committees and was a long-standing and, on occasion, the only tenor of the church choir. He enjoyed cycling, the running/walking group, line dancing, the Gospel Boys/Welsh Men's Choir, and spending time with his many friends.

Jack is survived by nephew, John; sister-in-law, Jean;

1st cousin, Beth and brother-in-law, Tony and his wife Jeryl.
